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What Fertilizer Should I Apply?

(Apply Fertilizer every 4-6 weeks)

Time of Year	Product to Apply	Reference
Mid February to Early March	New Lawn Starter (9-13-7)	Apply to give the root system of your existing lawn a boost; or use when seeding or laying sod.
	Tree & Shrub Food (19-8-10)	Apply also in late May and in mid October.
	Hi-Yield Iron+ and Natural Guard Soil Activator	Iron+ provides two of the three elements lacking in our alkaline soils, i.e., iron and sulfur. (Apply again in June, July, or August.) Provides microorganisms in the soil. This is the most important application for your lawn. (Apply again in June, July, or August.)
Late February to Mid March	All Seasons Lawn Food + Crabgrass and Weed Preventer (16-0-8)	An excellent product that contains a preemergent to control both grassy and broadleaf weeds in your lawn. 6 wks later apply post-emergent (see Early to mid May).
March, April, May, and June	Rhodie & Acid Loving Plant Food (9-15-13)	Feed your acid loving plants during each of these months.
Early May	Grub-Free Zone or Kill-a-Grub	Control bugs in your lawn now with Grub-Free Zone or Kill-a-Grub (Apply again in July or August)
Early to Mid May	Weed-Free Zone + Lawn Fertilizer (18-0-6) or Green Maker (18-0-6)	Time to remove actively growing weeds from your lawn. Weed-Free contains a post-emergent to control weeds and works great at lower temperatures. If weeds aren't a problem in your lawn, apply Green Maker. Contains iron and sulfur, two very important elements lacking in our soils. (Apply again in mid-Sept.)
Late May	Tree & Shrub Food (19-8-10)	Apply Tree & Shrub in February and October also.
Mid to Late June	Weed-Out + Lawn Fertilizer (25-0-4) Or Classic (16-0-8)	Time to remove actively growing weeds from your lawn. Weed-Out contains a post-emergent to control weeds If weeds aren't a problem, apply Classic during high temperature months-Contains a slow-release nitrogen formula that lasts 6 to 8 weeks.
June, July, or August	Natural Guard Soil Activator and Hi-Yield Iron+	Time for an application of Activator to enhance the availability of the fertilizer program. Also apply mid February to early March.) Apply Iron+ to help green up your lawn when it's stressed from the heat of summer.
July to August	Grub-Free Zone or Kill-a-Grub	Apply Grub-Free Zone or Kill-a-Grub to control the summer hatch.
Mid September	Green Maker (18-0-6)	Green Maker not only provides well-balanced fertilizer, but also gives the final application of iron and sulfur for the year.
Mid October	Winterizer (25-0-6) and Tree & Shrub Food (19-8-10)	Fall is the most critical time of the year to feed your lawn! Winterizer strengthens the lawn and provides disease resistance to lawn, trees, and shrubs. Apply Tree & Shrub food now to promote root growth.
