- Keep Asters, and Mums 3" High until the 4th of July
- Keep Removing Spent Blooms on Roses & other Flowers for Continued Blooms
- Apply Classic Fertilizer for Lawns (16-0-8) during Higher Summer Temperatures or Weed-Out Plus Fertilizer if you need to control Weeds in your Lawn.
- Apply Azalea, Camellia, & Rhododendron Food one Last Time
- Prune spring Flowering Shrubs such as: Lilacs, Forsythia, & Rhododendrons
- Mulch Trees & Perennials, Keep Mulch 8" away from Trunk to avoid Disease
- Stop Fertilizing Trees by June
